



The Committee on Building and Grounds, or Maintenance Committee, consists of one Board member and six others, each serving three year terms on a rotation basis. A Chairman (not necessarily the Board member) and Secretary are elected from among Committee members.

1. Concerns itself with the adequate use and maintenance of all physical property of the Thunder Bay Christian School Society.
2. Coordinates and plans a program of needed capital improvements.
3. Gives direction in the purchase of all furnishings, equipment, and building supplies.
4. Provides for an inventory of physical equipment.
5. Supervises and acts upon matters related to janitorial personnel. Is responsible for hiring, setting wages, job description, etc.
6. Is responsible to review and maintain adequate rental policies regarding school facilities and/or equipment.
7. Is responsible for the aesthetic image which the school facility presents, to demonstrate our stewardship concerns for the Lord's blessings.
8. Supervises purchasing of general supplies, equipment, services, insurance, etc.
9. Does an annual walk-through review or inspection with the school principal to determine necessary improvements to be completed in the summer or during other vacation periods.
10. Works with any committee for new or remodeling construction, to insure that such activity fits in with the over-all plans for the school.
